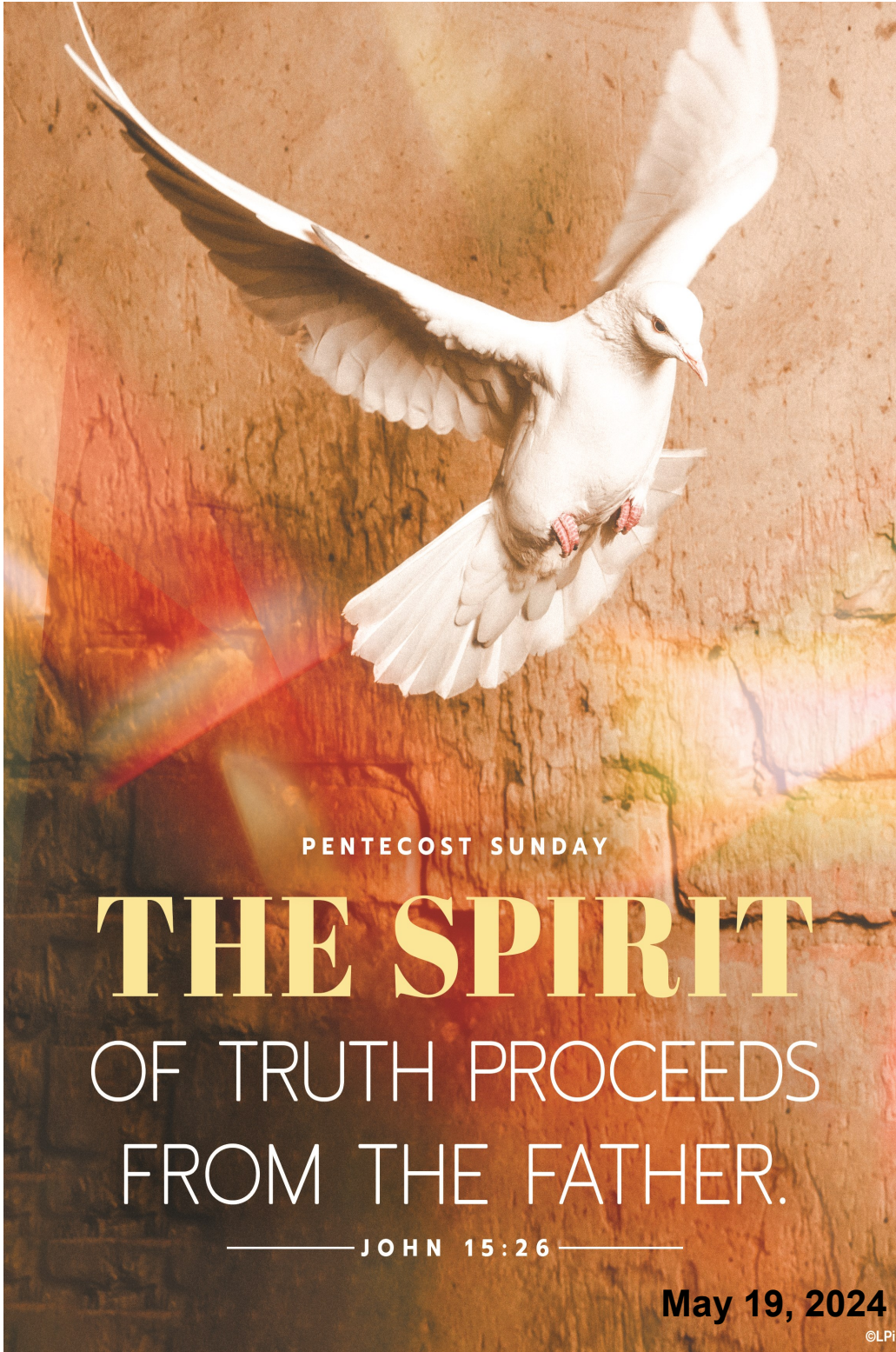

Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

Today, on Pentecost, the Gospel provides an account of the giving of the Holy Spirit. Jesus returned and sent his disciples out on mission, and breathed on them, calling how God breathed on the lump of clay, and brought life to the first humans according to the Book of Genesis' symbolic narrative. (Gn 2:7). Therefore, Jesus' disciples, us, are called to, and given new life in the Spirit. Jesus not only offers his disciples forgiveness in this outpouring of the Spirit, but he also charges them with sharing his forgiveness and peace through the Holy Spirit.

Too often, like Jesus' first disciples, we may be locked in closed rooms walled by individualism, divisions and prejudice and with the doors closed for fear. However, our Risen Lord is able to go through those walls and doors. Today, he encounters us in the midst of our challenges and struggles. Jesus shatters our fears and opens our horizons giving us new life. God's Spirit is the spirit of Love, the opposite of fear. The Spirit gives his disciples the courage to face any fears, challenge or hostility in their journey.

As Jesus' disciples preached on Pentecost, everyone was able to understand them in their own languages. Beyond the gift of all speaking one common language, they were all given the gift of understanding each other, and of embracing their diversity while united by the Gospel.

On Pentecost, God reminds us that we have the capacity to live our lives of faith and community. Because we have received the Gospel, listened, learned, and changed. We have the ability to love others, to care for one another, and to live justly in relationships with those who are the poorest. This life of discipleship brings challenges, but is worth it. Through the Spirit we are renewed, resist sin, fight injustice and build community.

We are very grateful to God for the Holy Spirit's gifts that He has poured into our community. This year, we have seen the Holy Spirit active not only through the work of our ministries, but in a new and urgent emphasis on announcing the Gospel to our family and neighbors. We are forever grateful to God for the wonderful gift of the Holy Spirit.

Hoy, en Pentecostés, el Evangelio narra la acción del Espíritu Santo. Jesús regresó y envió a sus discípulos en misión, y respiró sobre ellos, recordándonos cómo Dios respiró su aliento sobre el trozo de arcilla y así dio vida a los primeros seres humanos según el relato simbólico del Libro del Génesis (Gn 2,7). Por lo tanto, sus discípulos, nosotros, somos llamados y recibimos nueva vida en el Espíritu. Jesús no sólo ofrece a sus discípulos el perdón en esta efusión del Espíritu, sino que también les encarga compartir su perdón y paz a través del Espíritu Santo.

Muchas veces, como aquellos primeros discípulos de Jesús, podemos estar encerrados en cuartos amurallados por el individualismo, las divisiones y los prejuicios, con las puertas cerradas por el miedo. Sin embargo, nuestro Señor Resucitado es capaz de atravesar esos muros y esas puertas. Hoy nos encuentra en medio de nuestros desafíos y luchas. Jesús rompe nuestros miedos y abre nuestros horizontes dándonos nueva vida. El Espíritu de Dios es el espíritu de amor, lo opuesto al miedo. El Espíritu da a sus discípulos el valor para enfrentar cualquier temor, desafío u hostilidad en su camino.

Mientras los discípulos de Jesús predicaban en Pentecostés, todos podían entenderlos en sus propios idiomas. Más allá del don de hablar todos un mismo idioma, a todos se les dio el don de entenderse unos a otros y de celebrar su diversidad unidos por el Evangelio.

En Pentecostés, Dios nos recuerda que tenemos la capacidad de vivir nuestras vidas de fe y comunidad. Porque hemos recibido el Evangelio, hemos escuchado, aprendido y cambiado. Tenemos la capacidad de amar a los demás, de cuidarnos unos a otros y de vivir con justicia en las relaciones con los más pobres. Esta vida de discipulado trae desafíos, pero vale la pena. A través del Espíritu somos renovados, resistimos al pecado, luchamos contra la injusticia y construimos comunidad.

Estamos muy agradecidos con Dios por los dones del Espíritu Santo que Él ha derramado en nuestra comunidad. Este año, hemos visto al Espíritu Santo activo no solo a través del trabajo de nuestros ministerios, sino también en un nuevo y urgente énfasis en anunciar el Evangelio a nuestras familias y vecinos. Estamos eternamente agradecidos a Dios por el inmenso don del Espíritu Santo.

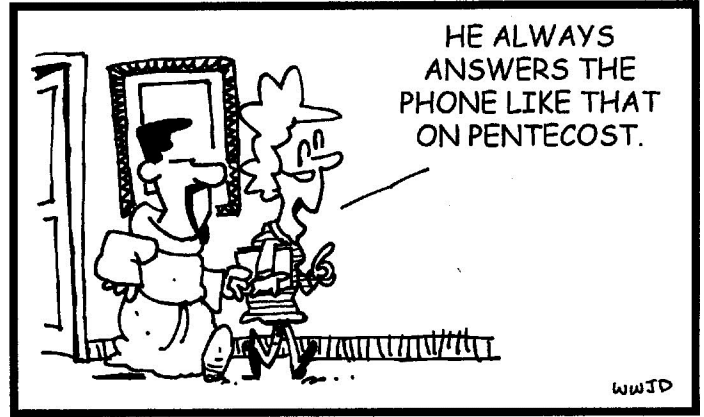

EVERYDAY STEWARDSHIP - RECOGNIZE GOD IN YOUR ORDINARY MOMENTS

You Don't Have What It Takes — but You Will

Those of us in ministry love this saying: God doesn't call the equipped. He equips the called.

We all know that sort of queasy feeling we get in the pit of our stomachs when it becomes clear what we're supposed to do, in any situation. It's that feeling of: *Oh, no. Not me. Not now. I can't.*

We've all got our list of reasons why not, don't we? We do it for everything, from big life problems to small everyday choices. I'm not going to invite my neighbor to church because I don't want to come across as pushy. I'm not going to make amends with my cousin because she'll just walk all over me again. I'm not going to say a Rosary tonight because I'm tired and it'll just stress me out.

However, even if we all put our lists of "reasons why we can't" together, I don't think any of us have reasons quite as valid as the apostles. Their job was to convert the nations — and here they are, a bunch of fishermen who haven't been out of Judea, who speak only their own languages. Were they supposed to preach the Gospel via a particularly compelling game of charades?

But even that big, giant, stop-you-dead-in-your tracks Reason Why We Can't was nothing, because God had a plan. He didn't call a bunch of equipped men. He called them, and He equipped them. Cue the tongues of fire!

God doesn't call us to do His will because we have what it takes. He calls us because He's ready to give us what it takes. Being a good steward is to answer the call of Christ knowing he will provide.
