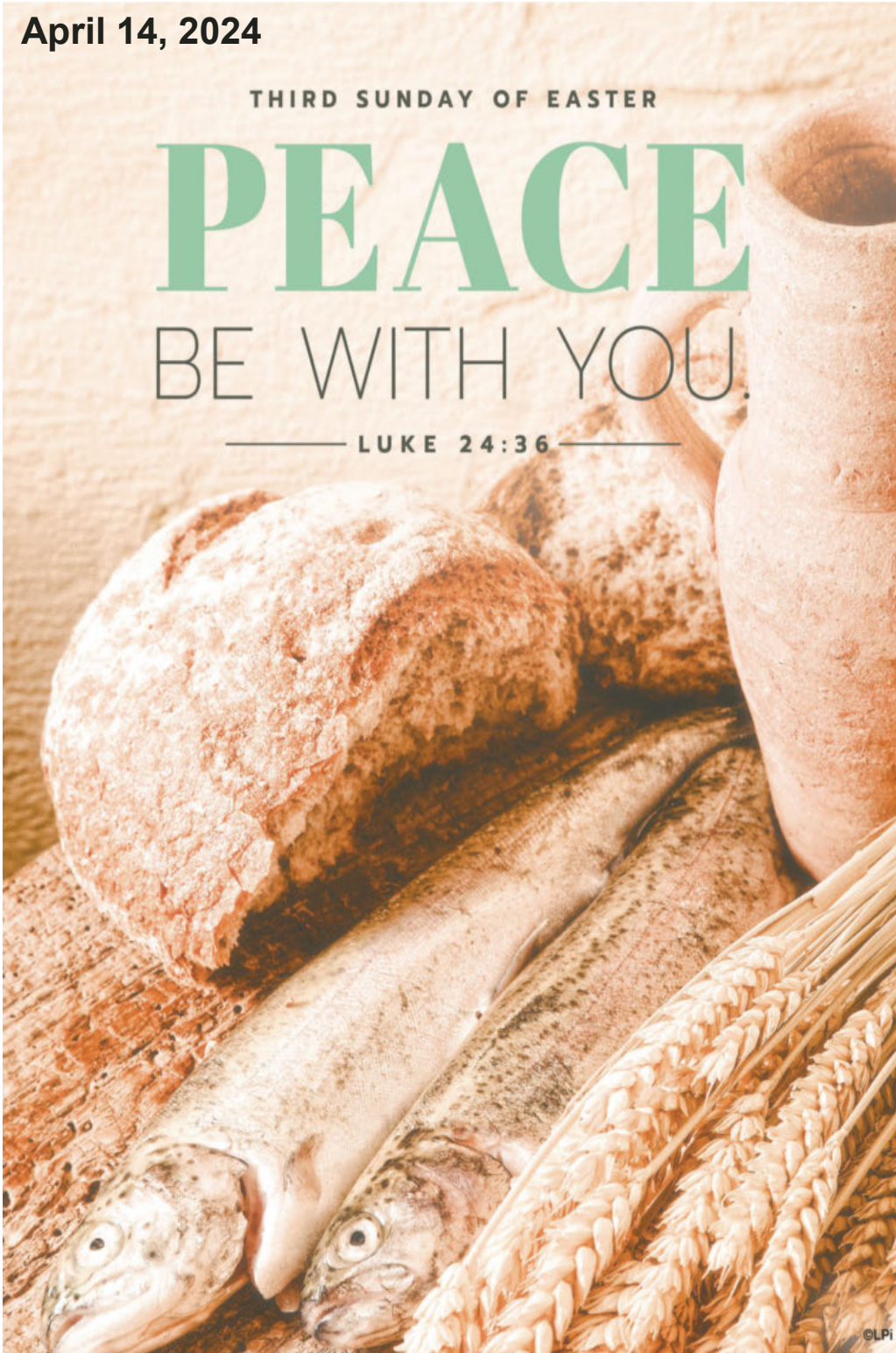

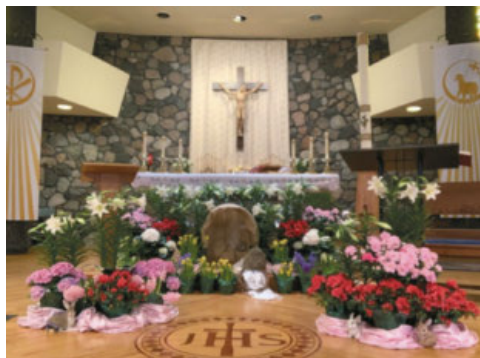

Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

Isn't it wonderful to see the Resurrected Jesus invite himself to lunch with his disciples? Today's Gospel image is truly amazing proof that Jesus had resurrected in his body, and that He was not a ghost or a construct of the imagination. Jesus had made himself known to the disciples on their way to Emmaus in the breaking of the bread. Then he appeared to his disciples who were still processing the painful experience of his death on the cross. Many of them were still carrying traumatic memories and remorse for having abandoned-or denied their friend and teacher at his toughest hour. At the sight of the Resurrected Jesus, the disciples were overcome with perplexity and doubt while Jesus only seemed to say: "it is I myself, see my wounds... do you have any lunch?"

Jesus does not judge or condemn his disciples, but once more offers his pardon and patience. He says: "Peace be with you" and takes the time to explain to them the coherence of his Passion to the Scripture's prophecies. "The Christ was to suffer and rise from the dead... for the repentance and forgiveness of sins."

Our encounter with the resurrected Jesus today brings a sense of perplexity and doubt, sometimes even fear. However, He still comes to you making himself known in the breaking of the bread. We realize the resurrected Jesus' presence at both the transformative and the ordinary moments of our life. In spite of confusion and unworthiness, we are confident that Jesus' voice breaks through the noise of this world, speaking the same words to you that he said to his disciples: "Peace be with you... you are witnesses to these things".



¿No es maravilloso ver a Jesús resucitado invitarse a almorzar con sus discípulos? La imagen del Evangelio de hoy es una prueba asombrosa de que Jesús había resucitado en su cuerpo, y que Él no era un fantasma o una construcción de la imaginación. Jesús se había dado a conocer a los discípulos en el camino a Emaús en el partir del pan. Ahora se le aparece a sus discípulos que todavía procesaban la dolorosa experiencia de su muerte en la cruz. Muchos de ellos todavía llevaban amargos recuerdos y remordimientos por haber abandonado o negado a su maestro en la hora más difícil. Al ver a Jesús resucitado, los discípulos se llenan de asombro, temor y duda, mientras que Jesús sólo parece decirles: "Soy yo mismo, mira mis heridas... ¿Tienes algo para almorzar?"

Jesús no juzga ni condena a sus discípulos, sino que les ofrece su perdón y paciencia una vez más. Él dice: "La paz esté con ustedes", y se toma el tiempo para explicarles la coherencia de su Pasión a las profecías de la Escritura. "El Cristo iba a sufrir y resucitar de entre los muertos... para el perdón de los pecados."

Nuestro encuentro con Jesús resucitado también hoy nos sumerge en perplejidad y duda, a veces incluso miedo. Sin embargo, Él todavía viene a ti dándose a conocer en el partir del pan. Pues nos damos cuenta de la presencia de Jesús resucitado tanto en los momentos transformadores como en los ordinarios de nuestra vida. A pesar de nuestra confusión y de no ser dignos de ello, estamos seguros de que la voz de Jesús atraviesa el ruido de este mundo, diciéndote las mismas palabras que dijo a sus primeros discípulos: "La paz esté con ustedes... y ustedes son testigos de esto".

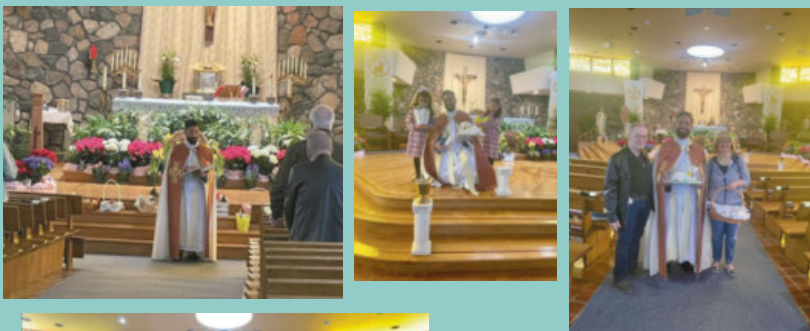
