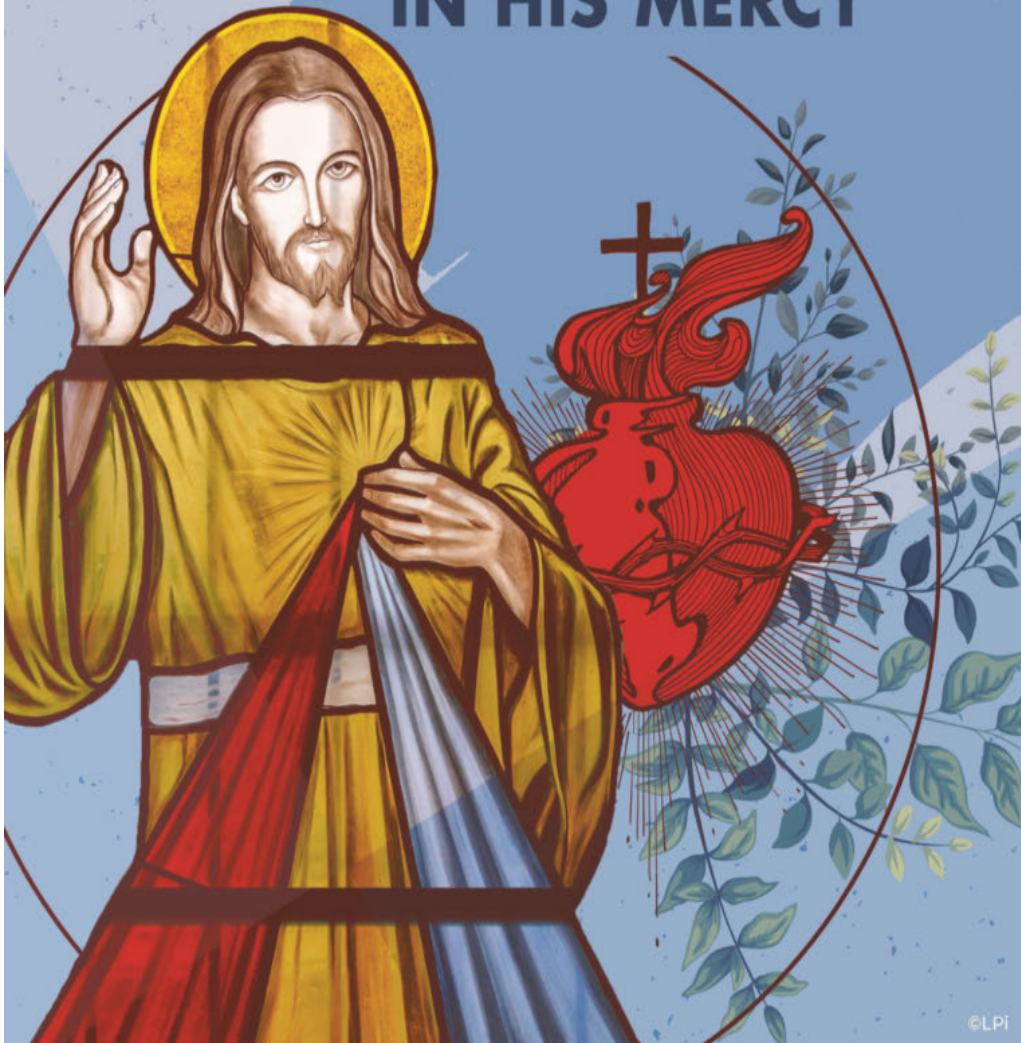

## Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

Today, we celebrate the feast of God's Mercy. The opening prayer addresses the Father as "God of everlasting Mercy" and we repeat three times in the psalm, "*His love is Everlasting!*" God revealed His mercy, first and foremost, by sending His only begotten Son to become our Savior and Lord by His suffering, death and Resurrection. Divine Mercy is given to us also in each celebration of the Sacraments, which were instituted to sanctify us. Our first reading (Acts 2:42-47), shows us how the early Church grew every day because of the acts of mercy and sharing, sacrificial agápe love, practiced by the early Christians.



Today's Gospel emphasizes the importance of Faith in the all-pervading presence of the risen Lord of Mercy. To "believe without having seen" is every Christian's experience. We are invited to receive liberation from doubts and hesitation by surrendering our lives to the risen Lord of Mercy. Let us ask God our Father to open our hearts so that we may receive His Mercy in the form of the Holy Spirit.

Therefore, we are not meant to keep the gift of Faith locked in our hearts, but to share it with our children, our families and our neighbors, always remembering the words of Pope St. John XXIII: "Every believer in this world must become a spark of Christ's light." "We all have scars from our own Good Fridays that remain long after our own experiences of resurrection. Our 'nail marks' remind us that all pain and grief, all humiliation and suffering, are transformed into healing and peace in the love of God that we experience from others and that we can extend to them. The "nail marks" of Jesus are all around us in the lives of those walking their own Calvarys. Jesus calls us to be willing to place ourselves in the pain and struggle of others and bring the healing and peace of Easter to the world.

Hoy celebramos la fiesta de la Misericordia de Dios. La oración de colecta se dirige al Padre como "Dios de Misericordia eterna" y repetimos tres veces en el salmo: "*¡Su misericordia es eterna!*" Dios reveló su misericordia, ante todo, al enviar a su único Hijo engendrado para que se convirtiera en nuestro Salvador y Señor mediante su sufrimiento, muerte y Resurrección. La Misericordia Divina también se nos da en cada celebración de los Sacramentos, que fueron instituidos para santificarnos. Como nuestra primera lectura (Hechos 2:42-47) nos muestra cómo la Iglesia primitiva crecía cada día a través de actos de misericordia y comunidad, o sea a través del amor sacrificado "agápe" de los primeros cristianos.

El Evangelio de hoy enfatiza la importancia de la Fe en la presencia omnipresente del Señor resucitado de la Misericordia. Creer "sin haber visto" es la experiencia de todo cristiano. Estamos invitados a recibir liberación de dudas e indecisiones al entregar nuestras vidas al Señor resucitado de la Misericordia.

Por lo tanto, no estamos destinados a mantener el don de la Fe encerrado en nuestros corazones, sino a compartirlo con nuestros hijos, nuestras familias y nuestros vecinos, recordando siempre las palabras del Papa San Juan XXIII: "Todo creyente en este mundo debe convertirse en una chispa de la luz de Cristo". Todos tenemos cicatrices de nuestros propios Viernes Santos que permanecen mucho tiempo después a pesar de nuestras propias experiencias de resurrección. Nuestras 'marcas de los clavos' nos recuerdan que todo dolor y aflicción, toda humillación o sufrimiento, se transforman en sanación y paz en el amor de Dios que experimentamos de los demás y que les brindamos. Las "marcas de los clavos" de Jesús están por todas partes en las vidas de aquellos que caminan por sus propios Calvarios. Jesús nos llama a estar dispuestos a solidarizarnos en el dolor y la lucha de los demás y llevar la sanación y la paz de la Pascua al mundo.

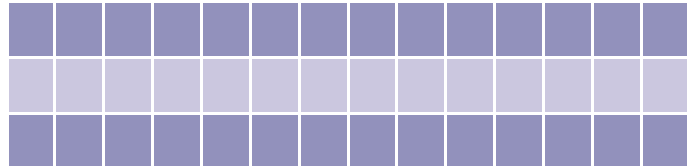

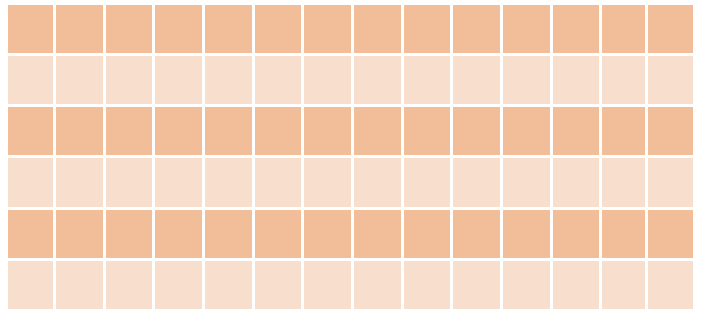

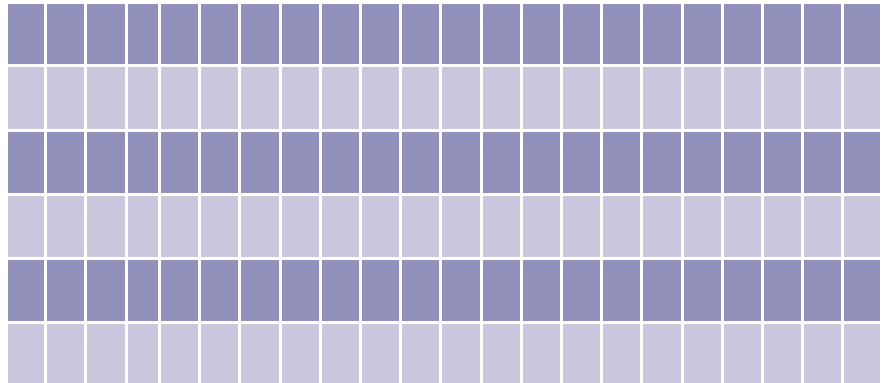
