Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

On today's solemnity, we are invited to meditate on the Mystery of the Most Holy Trinity. We rejoice that our God has revealed himself as one God in three persons. This teaching is not only our most essential faith dogma, but also the one we most frequently affirm. Every time we sign ourselves with the sign of the cross we do in the name of the Triune God by saying: "in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit." Moreover, we recite it every Sunday at Mass when we pray the Nicene Creed: We believe in God the Father, in Jesus Christ and in the Holy Spirit.

Although we have come to know God in three divine Persons, the intricacies of their relation and how they share being, action and glory remain a mystery to us. In the Gospel today (Jn 16:12-15), Jesus speaks about the close relationship of the three divine persons, and of how they are inseparable in the work of salvation and sanctification of the world. Therefore, as we worship, serve and evangelize through the Holy Spirit, whom Jesus sent over his disciples, God the Father is present too with the infinite wisdom with which he created this wonderful universe (Prv 8:22-31).

All the sacraments, and blessings are done in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. As a matter of fact, our life has been consecrated to God at baptism by invoking the Holy Trinity. Through the incarnation of the Son, Jesus Christ, and the continuous action of the Spirit in the Church we are partakers of the Trinity's divine life.

The Feast of the Most Blessed Trinity is a message of resilient hope for us (Rom 5:1-5) as it reminds us of the wondrous love God has for us. Through that love, we are compelled to respect and value every human person as a participant of God's divine life. And it also empowers us to follow the Son through a holy life, guided by the Holy Spirit, until we return to our Creator in Heaven. The unity of the one God in the diversity of the three divine persons is the image of the unity in diversity that the Church always strives to be. Blessings in the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity!

En la solemnidad de hoy, estamos invitados a meditar el Misterio de la Santísima Trinidad. Nos regocijamos de que nuestro Dios se haya revelado como un solo Dios en tres personas. Esta enseñanza es nuestro dogma de fe más esencial y es también el que afirmamos con más frecuencia. Cada vez que hacemos la señal de la cruz lo hacemos en el nombre del Dios Uno y Trino diciendo: "en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo". Además, lo recitamos todos los domingos en la Misa cuando rezamos el Credo de Nicea: Creemos en Dios Padre, en Jesucristo y en el Espíritu Santo.

Aunque hemos llegado a conocer a Dios en tres personas divinas, las complejidades de su relación y cómo comparten el ser, la acción y la gloria siguen siendo un misterio para nosotros. En el Evangelio de hoy (Jn 16,12-15), Jesús habla de la estrecha relación de estas tres personas divinas, y de cómo son inseparables en la obra de salvación y santificación del mundo. Por eso, mientras adoramos, servimos y evangelizamos por medio del Espíritu Santo, que Jesús envió sobre sus discípulos, se hace presente también Dios Padre con la infinita sabiduría con la que creó este maravilloso universo (Pr 8, 22-31).

Todos los sacramentos y bendiciones las hacemos en el nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo. De hecho, nuestra vida ha sido consagrada a Dios en el bautismo invocando a la Santísima Trinidad. Por la encarnación del Hijo Jesucristo, y la acción continua del Espíritu en la Iglesia, somos partícipes de la vida divina de la Trinidad.

La Fiesta de la Santísima Trinidad es un mensaje de duradera esperanza para nosotros (Rom 5:1-5) ya que nos recuerda el maravilloso amor que Dios tiene por nosotros. A través de ese amor, somos enviados a respetar y valorar a cada persona humana como participante de la vida divina de Dios. Y también recibimos el poder para seguir al Hijo a través de una vida santa, guiados por el Espíritu Santo, hasta que volvamos a nuestro Creador en el Cielo. La unidad del Dios único en la diversidad de las tres personas divinas es también la imagen de la unidad en la diversidad que la Iglesia se esfuerza siempre por ser. ¡Bendiciones en la Solemnidad de la Santísima Trinidad!
