Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

As we celebrate this solemn feast of Corpus Christi, the readings invite us to reflect deeply on the profound mystery of the Eucharist—the gift of Christ's Body and Blood given for our salvation.

In the passage from Exodus, we are transported to the covenantal scene at Sinai, where Moses, as mediator, ratifies the covenant between God and the people. The blood of sacrificial animals is sprinkled on the altar and the people, signifying their commitment to the covenant. This foreshadows the new and everlasting covenant sealed by the Precious Blood of Christ, as beautifully articulated in the letter to the Hebrews. Jesus, our high priest, offers himself as the perfect sacrifice, cleansing us from sin and reconciling us to the Father.

In Mark's Gospel, we hear the narrative of the Last Supper, where Jesus institutes the Eucharist. With words of deep significance, he takes bread, blesses it, and gives it to his disciples, saying, "Take; this is my body." Then, taking the chalice, he offers it to them, declaring, "This is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many." In these simple yet profound actions, Jesus institutes the sacrament of his Body and Blood, perpetuating his presence among us until the end of time.

As Catholics, we believe that in the Eucharist, we encounter the real presence of Christ—body, blood, soul, and divinity. It is not merely a symbol or remembrance but a true and substantial presence. Through the Eucharist, we are nourished and strengthened spiritually, united with Christ and with one another in the communion of the Church.

On this feast of Corpus Christi, let us approach the altar with hearts full of gratitude and reverence. May we recognize the immense love of God poured out for us in the gift of the Eucharist, and may we respond with lives of faith, love, and service, bringing Christ's presence into the world.

Al celebrar esta solemnidad de Corpus Christi, las lecturas nos invitan a reflexionar profundamente sobre el profundo misterio de la Eucaristía: el don del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo entregado para nuestra salvación.

En el pasaje del Éxodo, somos transportados a la escena de la alianza en el Sinaí, donde Moisés, como mediador, ratifica el pacto entre Dios y el pueblo. La sangre de los animales sacrificados es rociada sobre el altar y el pueblo, significando su compromiso con el pacto. Esto prefigura el nuevo y eterno pacto sellado por la Preciosa Sangre de Cristo, como se expresa en la carta a los Hebreos. Jesús, nuestro sumo sacerdote, se ofrece a sí mismo como el sacrificio perfecto, lavándonos del pecado y reconciliándonos con Dios Padre.

En el Evangelio según San Marcos, escuchamos el relato de la Última Cena, donde Jesús instituyó la Eucaristía. Con palabras de profundo significado, tomó pan, lo bendijo y se lo dio a sus discípulos, diciendo: "Tomen, esto es mi cuerpo". Luego, tomando el cáliz, se lo ofreció, declarando: "Esta es mi sangre de la alianza, que es derramada por muchos". En estas acciones simples pero profundas, Jesús instituyó el sacramento de su Cuerpo y Sangre, perpetuando su presencia entre nosotros hasta el fin de los tiempos.

Como católicos, creemos que en la Eucaristía encontramos la verdadera presencia de Cristo: cuerpo, sangre, alma y divinidad. No es simplemente un símbolo o recuerdo, sino una presencia verdadera y sustancial. A través de la Eucaristía, somos alimentados y fortalecidos espiritualmente, unidos con Cristo y con los demás en la comunión de la Iglesia.

En esta fiesta de Corpus Christi, acerquémonos al altar con corazones llenos de gratitud y reverencia. Que reconozcamos el inmenso amor de Dios derramado por nosotros en el don de la Eucaristía, y que respondamos con vidas de fe, amor y servicio, llevando la presencia de Cristo al mundo.

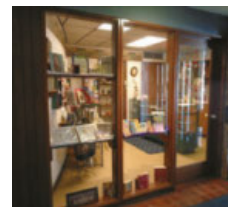
