

Scenario A: 1 united parish with 3 worship sites

St. Domitilla, St. Eulalia, Sacred Heart, and St. Simeon all unite to form one new canonical parish served by one pastor and staff team.

St. Domitilla, St. Eulalia, and Sacred Heart Churches would serve as worship sites of the new parish. St. Simeon Church would close.

Scenario B: 3 parishes remain in their current structures.

St. Domitilla and Sacred Heart would each remain in their current canonical structures.

St. Simeon would close, and St. Eulalia would be assigned responsibility for the pastoral care of the people of St. Simeon. This means the assets and financial liabilities of St. Simeon would become part of St. Eulalia as well.

Scenario C: 2 parishes, continuing all 4 churches as worship sites

Sacred Heart and St. Eulalia would form a new canonical parish, continuing to use both churches as worship sites of the new parish.

St. Domitilla and St. Simeon would form a new canonical parish, continuing to use both churches as worship sites of the new parish.

Scenario D: 2 parishes, continuing at 3 church sites

St. Domitilla, Sacred Heart, and St. Simeon would form a new canonical parish. St. Domitilla and Sacred Heart Churches would continue as worship sites of the new parish. St. Simeon Church would close.

St. Eulalia would continue in its current canonical structure.

Scenario E: 2 parishes, continuing at 3 church sites

St. Domitilla, St. Eulalia, and St. Simeon would form a new canonical parish. St. Domitilla and St. Eulalia Churches would continue as worship sites of the new parish. St. Simeon Church would close.

Sacred Heart would continue in its current canonical structure.
