



Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

On the fourth Sunday of Lent, the readings from John (3:14-21) and 2 Chronicles (36:14-16, 19-23) converge to illuminate the transformative power of faith and belief in Christ. The passage from John speaks profoundly of salvation through belief in Jesus, emphasizing the light that dispels darkness. This light symbolizes the transformative journey that faith sparks within us.

The parallel narrative in the Book of Chronicles recounts a tumultuous period, highlighting the consequences of turning away from God. Yet, even in the face of disobedience to God, there is hope and redemption. It sets the stage for reflection on personal accountability and the potential for renewal through faith.

This core message resonates in the call for a personal relationship with Jesus through prayer and spirituality. In a world often clouded by distractions and uncertainties, cultivating our relationship with God becomes a source of strength and guidance. The transformative power of faith is not merely theoretical but takes root in the daily conversations with God, fostering a profound sense of purpose and peace.

As we immerse ourselves in prayer and deepen our spirituality in this time of Lent, the readings prompt a call to action and solidarity with our neighbors. The transformative journey is not solitary; it urges us to extend the light we have found to others. This might manifest in acts of compassion, understanding, and support for those around us, but also in extending an invitation to others to meet Jesus. Our faith, when genuine, propels us towards a shared responsibility for the well-being of our community and the spreading of the Good News.

Today's readings encourage us to recognize the transformative power within our faith, the significance of a personal relationship with Jesus in prayer and spirituality, and the imperative to take this faith into action by standing in solidarity with our neighbors. As we navigate life's complexities, let our belief in Christ be a guiding light, radiating compassion and fostering positive change in both our hearts and the world.

En el cuarto domingo de Cuaresma, las lecturas de Juan (3:14-21) y 2 Crónicas (36:14-16, 19-23) convergen para iluminar el poder transformador de la fe y la confianza en nuestro Señor Jesucristo. El pasaje de Juan habla profundamente de la salvación mediante la fe en Jesús, enfatizando la luz que disipa las tinieblas. Esta luz simboliza el viaje transformador que la fe enciende en nuestra vida.

La historia paralela en el Libro de las Crónicas relata un período tumultuoso y destaca las consecuencias de alejarse de Dios. Sin embargo, incluso frente a la desobediencia a Dios, hay esperanza y redención. Él prepara el escenario para la reflexión sobre la responsabilidad personal y el potencial de renovación a través de la fe.

Este mensaje central resuena en el llamado a una relación personal con Jesús a través de la oración y la espiritualidad. En un mundo a menudo nublado por distracciones e incertidumbres, cultivar nuestra relación con Dios se convierte en una fuente de fortaleza y renovación. El poder transformador de la fe no es meramente teórico, sino que se arraiga en nuestras conversaciones diarias con Dios, fomentando un profundo sentido de propósito y paz.

Mientras nos sumergimos en oración y profundizamos nuestra espiritualidad en este tiempo de Cuaresma, las lecturas generan un llamado a la acción y la solidaridad con nuestro prójimo. Este camino transformador no es solitario, sino que nos insta a extender la Luz que hemos encontrado a los demás. Esto podría manifestarse en actos de compasión, ayuda y apoyo hacia quienes nos rodean, pero también en extender una invitación a otros a conocer a Jesús. Nuestra fe nos impulsa hacia una responsabilidad compartida por el bienestar de nuestra comunidad y la difusión de la Buena Nueva.

Las lecturas de hoy nos animan a reconocer el poder transformador de nuestra fe, la importancia de una relación personal con Jesús en oración y espiritualidad, y el imperativo de llevar esta fe a la acción siendo solidarios con nuestro prójimo. Mientras navegamos por las complejidades y desafíos de la vida, que nuestra creencia en Cristo sea esa luz que nos guíe, y que irradie compasión y fomente un cambio positivo tanto en nuestros corazones como en el mundo.
