



Pastor's Column/Carta del Párroco

In today's first reading (Jer 31:31-34), we encounter the prophetic promise of a new covenant, one not written on stone tablets, but inscribed upon the hearts of God's people. This covenant, a divine commitment to guide and redeem, finds its fulfillment in the words of Jesus in today's Gospel passage (Jn 12:20-33) as Jesus declares the imminent arrival of His passion.

In the footsteps of Abraham, the father of many nations, Jesus unfolds the fulfillment of the covenant God established with His chosen people by his sacrifice in the cross. The prophetic seeds sown in the Old Testament blossom into reality as Jesus foretells His impending sacrifice. The promised Messiah, embodying the covenant's essence, invites all of God's children into a profound connection through faith.

The passage from Jeremiah foreshadows a covenant not contingent on external adherence but engraved within the depths of human hearts and expressed mainly in human behavior. This internal transformation aligns with Jesus' proclamation in John, The transformative power of the cross signifies not just an external redemption but a profound inward renewal.

Our readings today underline the interconnectedness of God's plan throughout the history of salvation. Jesus, as the fulfillment of all prophecies, demonstrates the divine commitment to reconcile and renew us. Through His impending passion, Jesus signifies the ultimate covenantal act, inviting us all to partake in this profound promise of salvation.

As we begin the Fifth Week of Lent, these passages invite us to reflect on the enduring covenant of love that binds us to God. The sacrifice foretold by Jesus gives us courage, hope and endurance in the face of suffering. Let us thank God for his providential care for us, and let us allow him to shape our hearts, and embrace the transformative power of Christ's passion, the fulfillment of God's promise to His people across generations.



En la primera lectura de hoy (Jer 31:31-34), nos encontramos con la promesa profética de una nueva alianza, no escrita en tablas de piedra, sino grabado en los corazones del pueblo de Dios. Esta alianza, un compromiso divino para guiar y redimir, encuentra su cumplimiento en las palabras de Jesús en el pasaje del Evangelio de hoy (Jn 12:20-33) cuando Jesús declara la inminente llegada de Su pasión.

Siguiendo los pasos de Abraham, el padre de muchas naciones en la fe, Jesús lleva a cabalidad el cumplimiento de la alianza que Dios estableció con su pueblo por su sacrificio en la cruz. Las semillas proféticas sembradas en el Antiguo Testamento florecen en el Evangelio mientras Jesús predice su inminente sacrificio. El Mesías prometido, encarnando la esencia de la alianza, invita a todos los hijos de Dios a una conexión profunda a través de la fe.

El pasaje de Jeremías prefigura un pacto no dependiente del cumplimiento externo, sino grabado en las profundidades de los corazones humanos y expresado principalmente en el comportamiento humano. Esta transformación interna se alinea con la proclamación de Jesús en el Evangelio según Juan. El poder transformador de la cruz significa no solo redención externa, sino una renovación interna profunda.

Nuestras lecturas de hoy subrayan la interconexión del plan de Dios a lo largo de la historia de la salvación. Jesús, como cumplimiento de las profecías, demuestra el compromiso divino de reconciliarnos y renovarnos. A través de Su pasión inminente, Jesús significa el acto definitivo de la alianza, invitándonos a todos a participar en esta profunda promesa de salvación.

Al comenzar la Quinta Semana de Cuaresma, estos pasajes nos invitan a reflexionar sobre la eterna promesa de amor que nos une a Dios. El sacrificio predicho por Jesús nos da valor, esperanza y ánimo frente a las dificultades de nuestra vida. Agradecemos a Dios por su cuidado providencial y permitámonos moldear nuestros corazones, abrazando el poder transformador de la pasión de Cristo, el cumplimiento de la promesa de Dios a su pueblo a lo largo de las generaciones.
